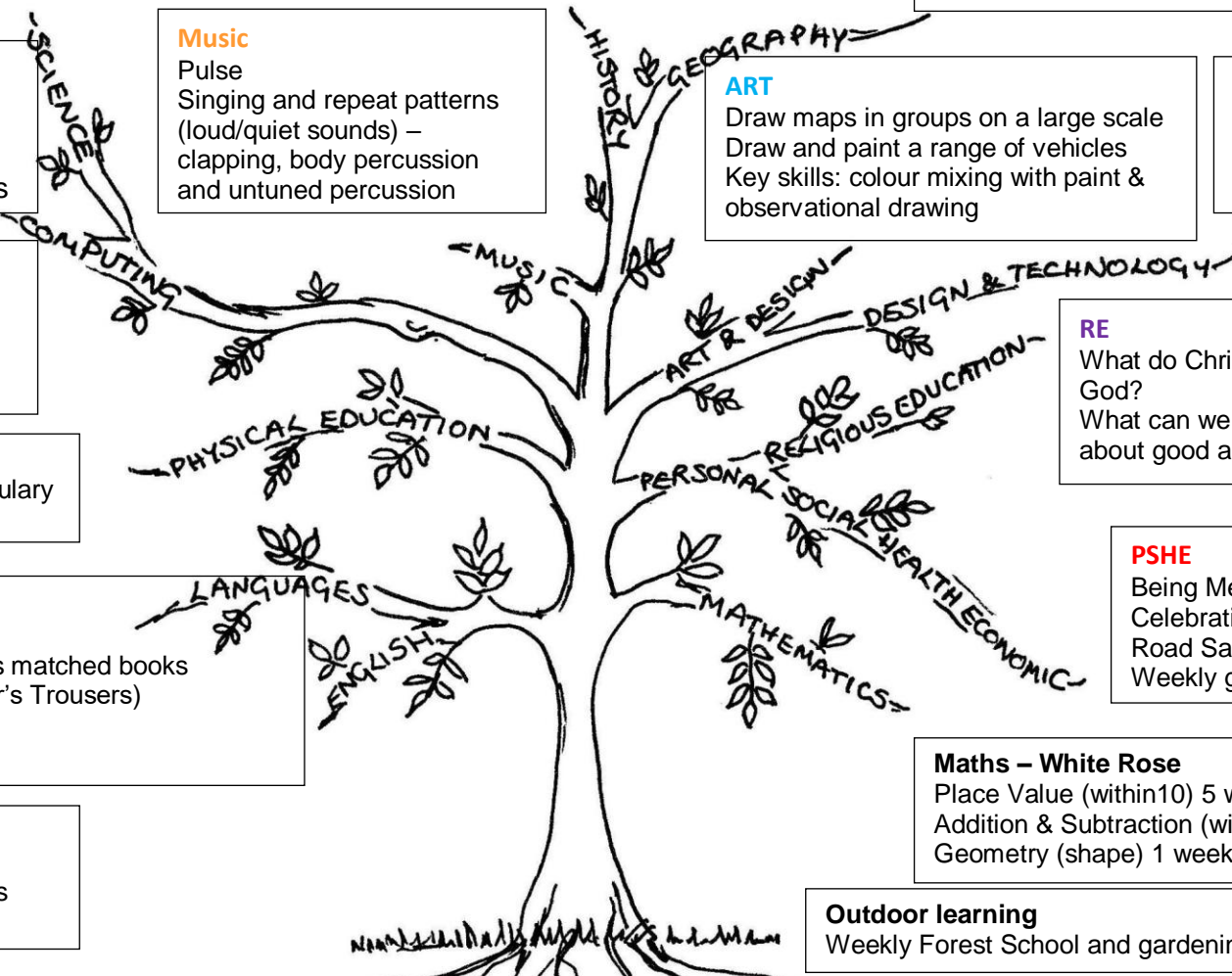
Language of the month – simple vocabulary (hello, goodbye etc)
